4	RR expressed reservations about reducing the speed as accidents could be and have been caused by slow-moving vehicles being overtaken. MP recognised that a reduction in the speed limit is not easily enforced and may not resolve the issues. A parishioner suggested that there should be a reduction in the speed limit along the whole of the Long Furlong and not just through the village. She suggested that double white lines could also be used at the corner by Myrtle Grove to prevent overtaking and reduce accidents. DT to enquire with highways and report back. Resolution 1 - PPC to support a reduction in speed from 40mph to 30mph jointly with Clapham Parish Council	DT
